


Race-Ready

GP TEK Shooting the lights out!

The brief was simple: design and build the lightest motorcycle wheel possible!

The result? The competition/track-specific GP TEK, which as a front wheel weighs just 3.9 lbs/1.77 kg and as a driven wheel is a mere 5.29 lbs/2.40 kg. A key feature is the use of specialised carbon fibre to tailor the cornering stiffness and reach an unprecedented level of rigidity.

Other noteworthy features are hubs machined from 6000 grade aircraft aluminium, fasteners of grade 5 titanium, and a new, BST-patented serviceable coating between the tyre and rim that protects the wheel from damage during tyre changing.

So that every individual wheel can be traced right back to its birth at any point in its lifespan, there is RFID tag for DNA traceability. This is not only an anti-theft measure (making the wheel identifiable with a simple, hand-held device) but means every component's background and history is known.
